5. Tell me about a new testing or sampling methodology or technology which you found very useful.
6. Share an experience in which you selected and implemented quality control equipment which you were happy with.
7. Tell me about a production sample you analyzed and were happy with the quality. How about a sample which was not of good quality?
8. Share an experience in which you successfully audited a subcontractor facility.
9. Tell me about a time when examining materials, samples, or products, helped you to better meet testing or inspection standards.
10. Tell me about the last documentation for regulatory submissions or inspections you reviewed.
